Neil Bolton was born in Suffolk in 1958. He studied at Ipswich School of Art, 1977-78 then Norwich School of Art, 1978-1981. For a number of years he worked as a member of the Art Department of Homerton College, Cambridge. Currently living in Ripon, Neil paints the British landscape and the human figure, exhibiting his work in a number of galleries.

Ian Shearman is a regular visitor to the Penwith region of Cornwall. For a number of years, Ian was the Head of Art at Homerton College, Cambridge, lecturing in all aspects of Fine Art to B.Ed and PGCE students. Taking the opportunity to pursue his own personal painting career, Ian has been working as a self-employed artist since 1997.
